

## Protect your data

#### with 3rd party verification

The National Institute of Standards and Technology (NIST) has been given the responsibility by the US Department of Commerce for developing information security standards and guidelines, including setting minimum requirements for US federal information systems. Have the assurance that your data has been securely erased to <a href="NIST 800-88 standards">NIST 800-88 standards</a> — your service provider can provide you with a certification of data destruction once the disposal process is complete.

Teaming up with leading tree planting organizations, the ITAD program is in partnership with veritree. For each computer workstation — desktop, thin client, or laptop — that goes through our disposition process, a tree will be planted in a US forest affected by drought and wildfire.

We ask that you include the power cord and/or AC adapter that came with the computer workstation. If any components can be reused, our recycling partner will make it happen. Use any old box available for shipping. Diverting materials from landfill is just the start.
